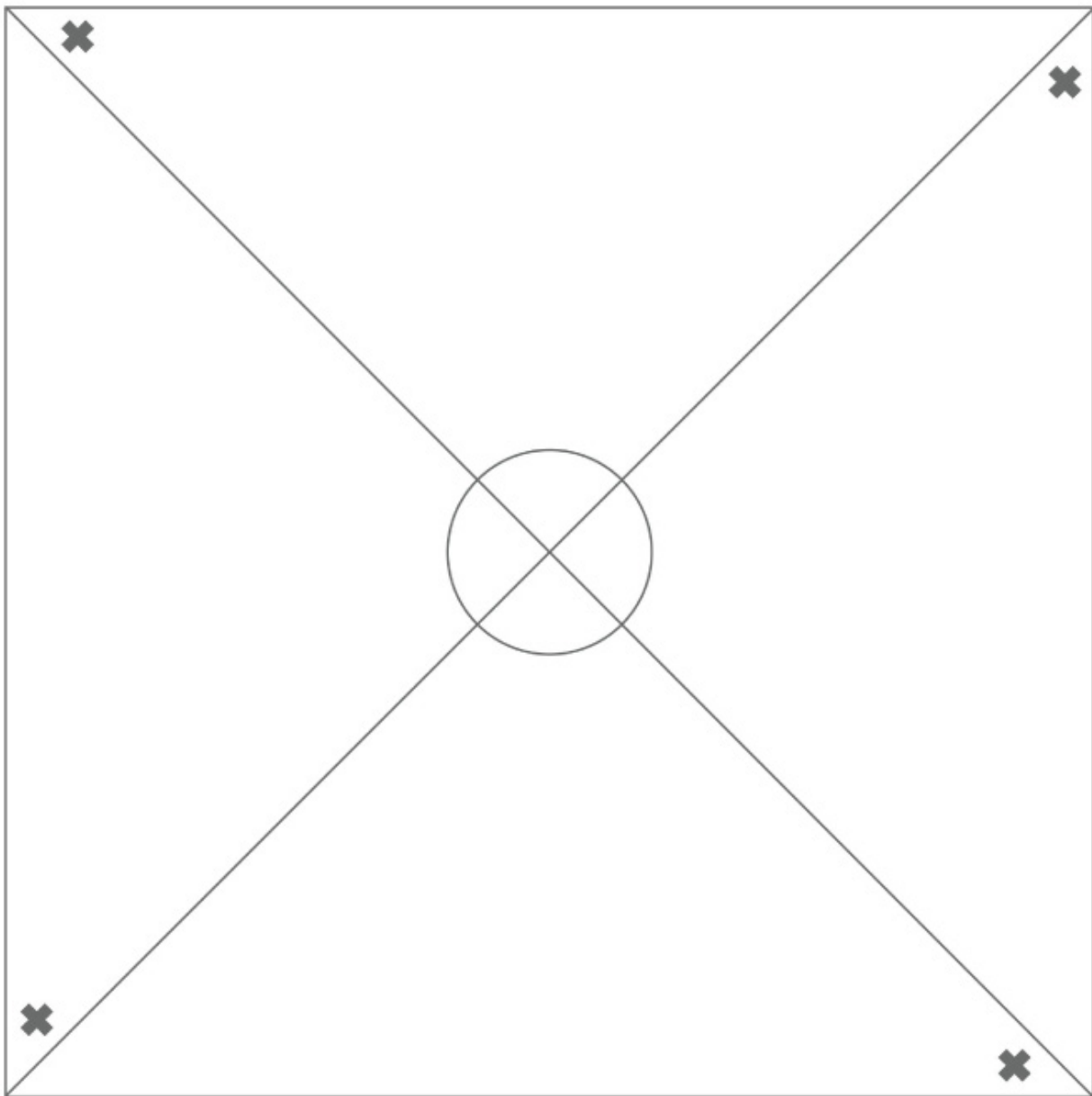


How to make a paper windmill

Instructions

1. Cut out the square windmill template below.
2. Decorate both sides then cut down the diagonal lines as far as the circle in the centre.
3. Bring the points marked with an X to the centre of the circle and x in place with glue.
4. Use a sharp pencil and a piece of plasticine to punch a small hole in the centre of the windmill.
5. Punch a hole approximately 2cm from the end of a drinking straw.
6. Attach the windmill to the straw using a brass paper fastener.

NB: The windmill template should be a 16cm square, with two lines connecting the opposite corners and a circle in the centre, 3cm in diameter. There should be crosses in the places marked below.
