


How to make a paper windmill

Instructions

- 1. Cut out the square windmill template below.
- 2. Decorate both sides then cut down the diagonal lines as far as the circle in the centre.
- 3. Bring the points marked with an X to the centre of the circle and x in place with glue.
- 4. Use a sharp pencil and a piece of plasticine to punch a small hole in the centre of the windmill.
- 5. Punch a hole approximately 2cm from the end of a drinking straw.
- 6. Attach the windmill to the straw using a brass paper fastener.

NB: The windmill template should be a 16cm square, with two lines connecting the opposite corners and a circle in the centre, 3cm in diameter. There should be crosses in the places marked below.
