Is it OK to accuse someone of stealing if you didn't see what happened?



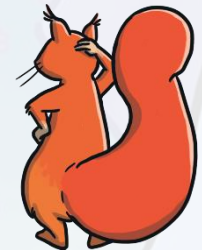
What Would You Do?

The animals get very cross. They gang up to accuse each other of stealing.



If you think someone might have done something wrong, is it OK to confront them as a group?

What would be the best way to talk about the problem?



What Would You Do?

When the animals first see the monster, they try to run away.

Why are the animals scared of the monster?

How would you feel if people ran away from you?



What Would You Do?

We find out that a monster has been taking the animals' food to organise a surprise party for them.

Why did the monster want to have a party with the animals?



How do you think the monster feels living alone in the forest?



What Would You Do?

When the animals learn that the monster is just trying to make friends, they say sorry to the monster.



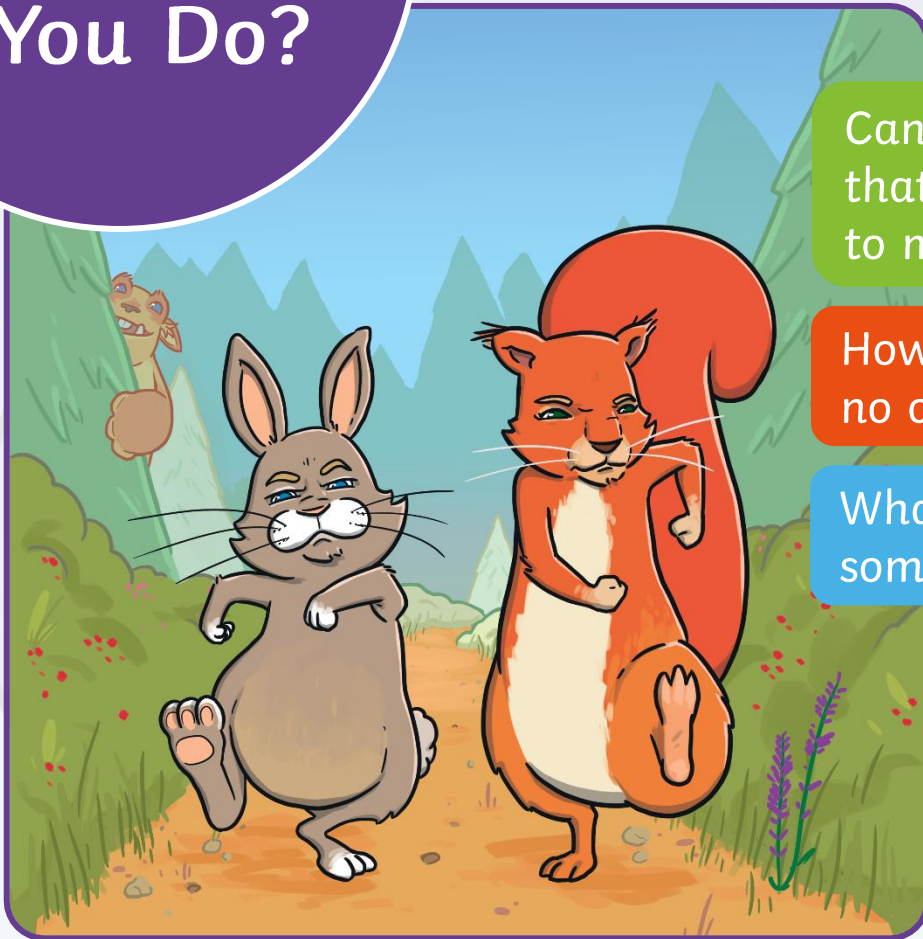
Was the monster right to take the animals' food?
