Topic: Easter

Focus: Explore accounts of the Resurrection appearances of Christ in the four Gospel.

Topic: Pentecost

Focus: study the story of Pentecost and identify the effects that it had upon the disciples.

Science

Topic: Sound

Focus: Learn about sound; how it travels, pitch and volume. Then investigate materials to see which will provide the best insulation against sound.

Art

Topic: Mythical Creatures

Focus: Create a mythical creature using plasticine inspired by Roman and Viking mythology.

Music

Topic: Haiku, Movement and Performance

Focus: Japanese inspired topic which looks at the springtime festival of Hanami, which celebrates the fleeting beauty of spring flowers.

English – Writing

Poetry: Cinquains

Focus: Understand the structure of Cinquains through analysing examples before creating own.

Topic: Recount Writing.

Focus: Explore recounts through Little Mouse's Big Book of Fears (Emily Gravett), After the Fall (Dan Santat) and The Dark (Lemony Snicket).

Guided Reading – Electricity, Vikings, Notable People Volume 2, Disney Songs.

Maths

Topic: Fractions

Focus: Recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities, including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number.

Topic: Decimals

Focus: Compare numbers with the same number of decimal places up to two decimal places, solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.

PSHE

Topic: Tenten resources

Focus: Study life cycles, a community of love and what is the church?

Computing

Topic: Animation

Focus: Follow multi-step instructions to create stop-start animations.

MFL

Topic: Les Habitats

Focus: Speak and write about different habitats and animals in French.

History

Topic: Vikings

Focus: Extend upon prior learning, finding out about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England and how England became a unified country.

PE

Topic: Swimming (continued)

Focus: Participate in swimming sessions at the Crystal Leisure Centre

Topic: Cricket

Focus: Pupils practice the principles of attack vs defence in a cricket context. They will practice a range of fielding skills and develop their batting skills to score as many runs as possible.
