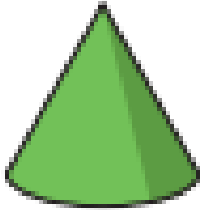


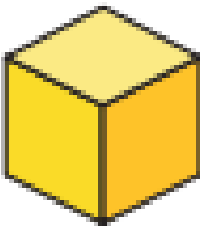

I Match each shape to its name.



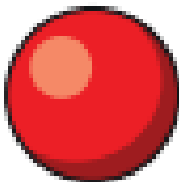
sphere



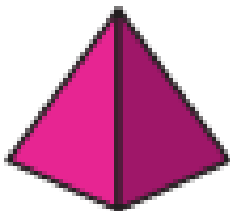
cone



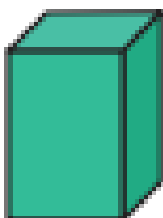
cuboid
