

instinctively:

Adverb

To do something without thinking as if natural.

Synonyms:

Natural, spontaneous.

“Dragon's instinctively hide from humans ”



demolishing:

Verb

To pull down or break something up.

Synonyms:

Destroy, bulldoze, topple, flatten.

“He was only interested in demolishing Grandad’s lettuces.”



lurking:

Verb

Remain hidden to spy or wait to ambush or pounce on someone.

Synonyms:

Hide, lurk, stalk.

“I could picture all sorts of things lurking behind the hedges.”



tempting:

Adjective

Appealing or attractive to someone even if wrong or unwise.

Synonyms:

Attractive, enticing, alluring.

“I looked at Grim’s vegetable patch and the tempting greenery.”
