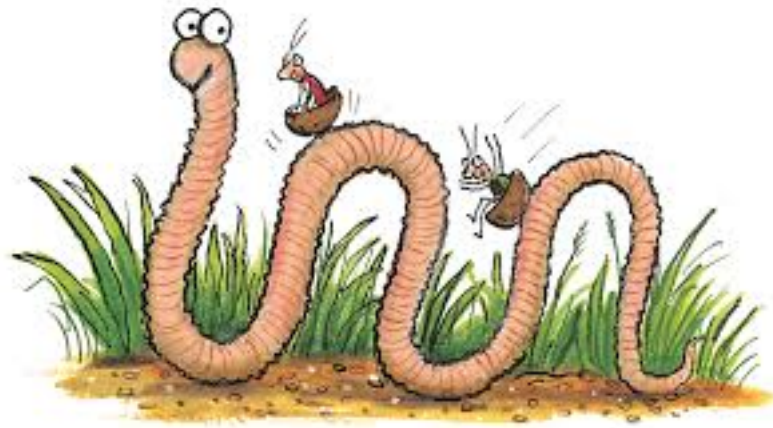

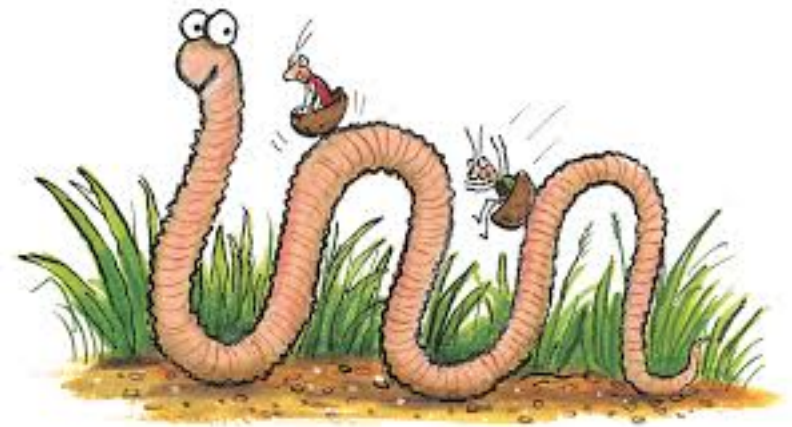

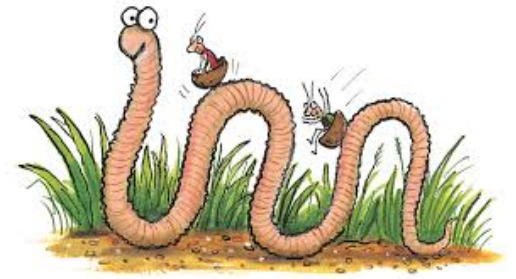

Superworm is very long and strong.

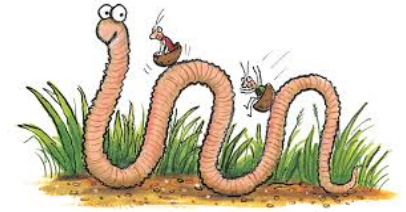

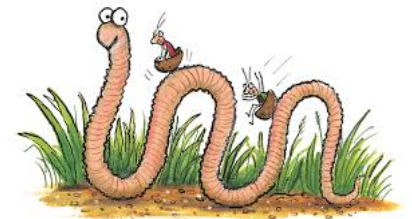
