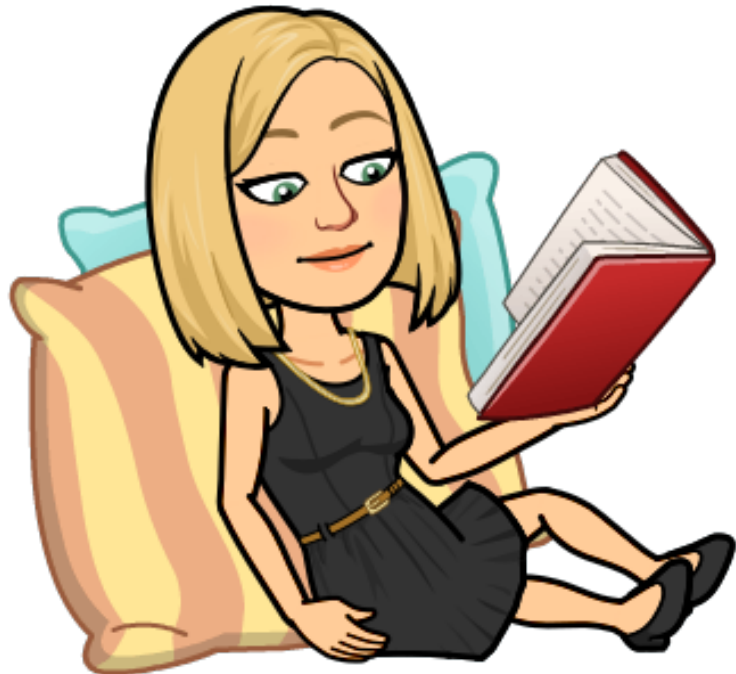


Year 2's Next Read!

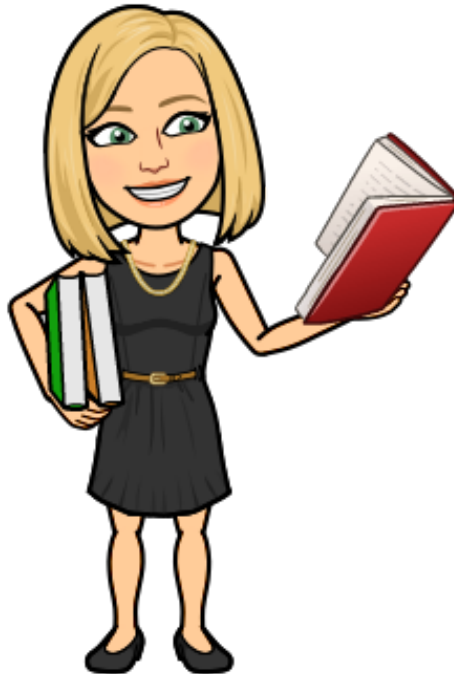
Marge in Charge by Isla Fisher

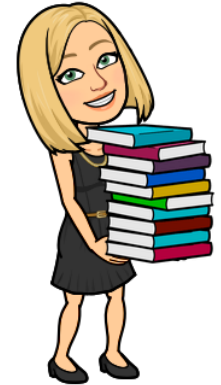

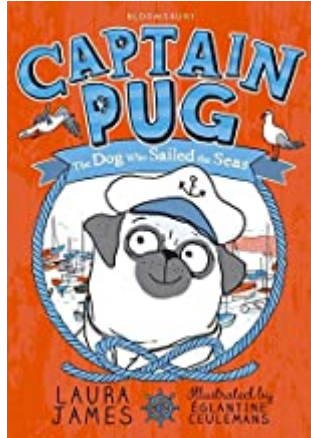
Guinea Pig Superstar by Ali Pye
