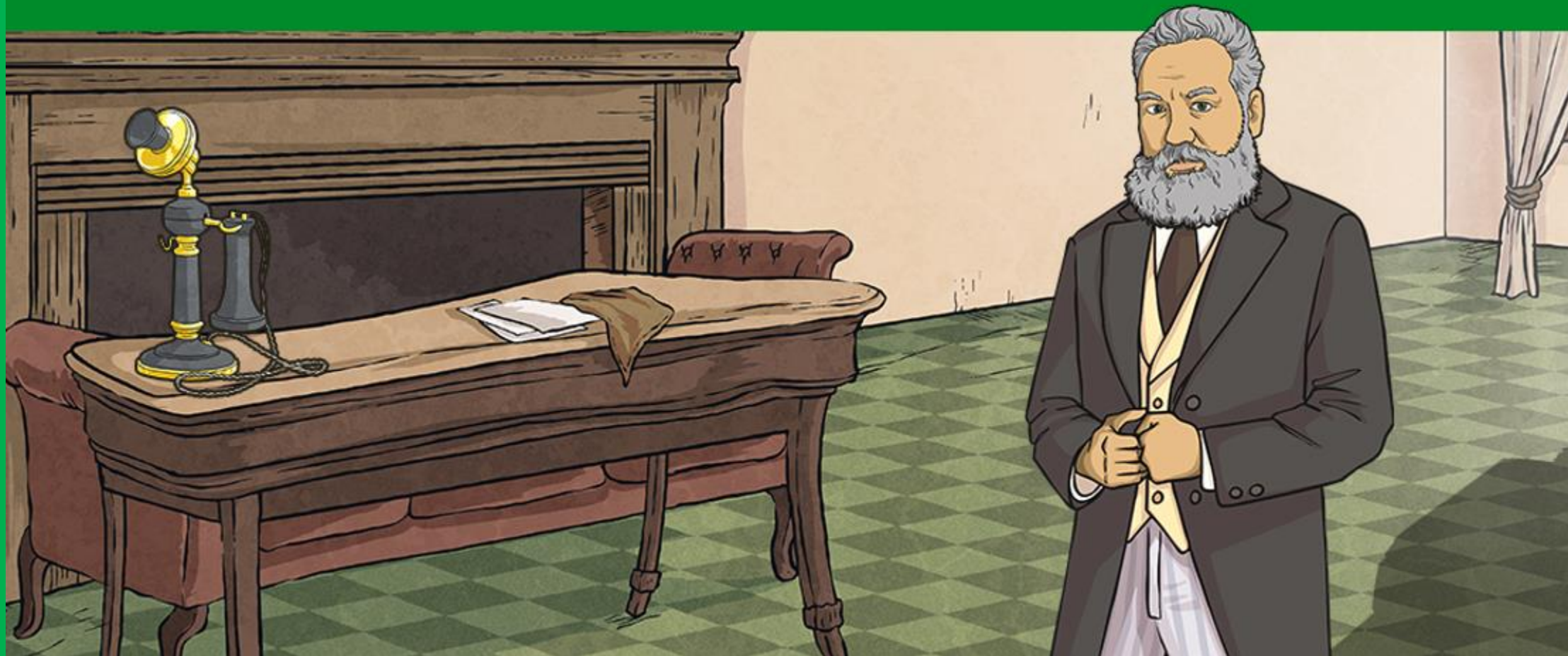

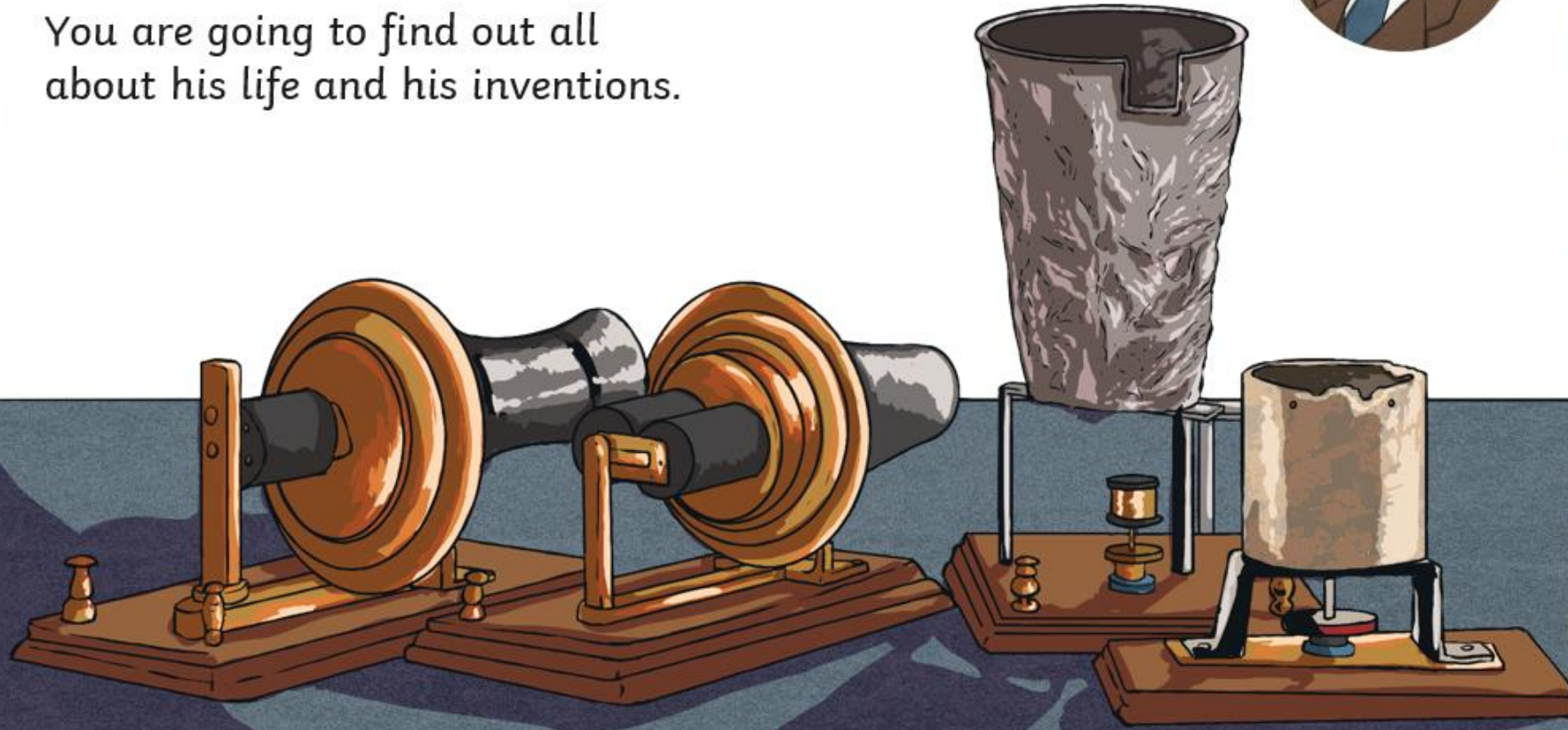

# Alexander Graham Bell

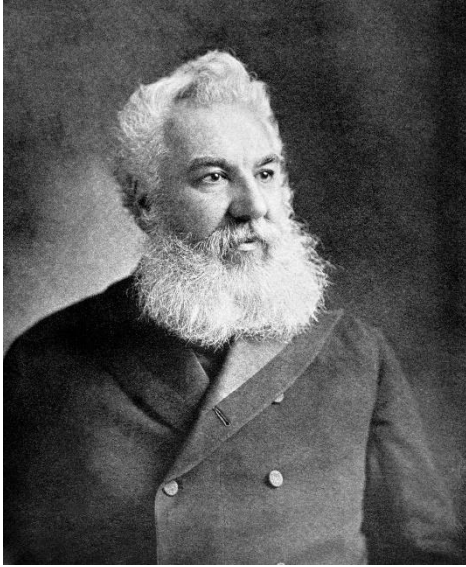
Alexander Graham Bell was a Scottish scientist and inventor. His most famous invention was the first telephone.
